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Precautions :

If you can confirm the link with either DSC-ID account service or EUVS, it will be linked.

Due to system specifications, if you apply for linkage on EUVS, you can only confirm the linkage on EUVS.

(Even if you check from the DSC-ID account service, the linkage cannot be confirmed)


[EUVS] How to check if your DSC-ID and M365 account are linked if you are a temporary employee, contract employee, supplier, etc.
